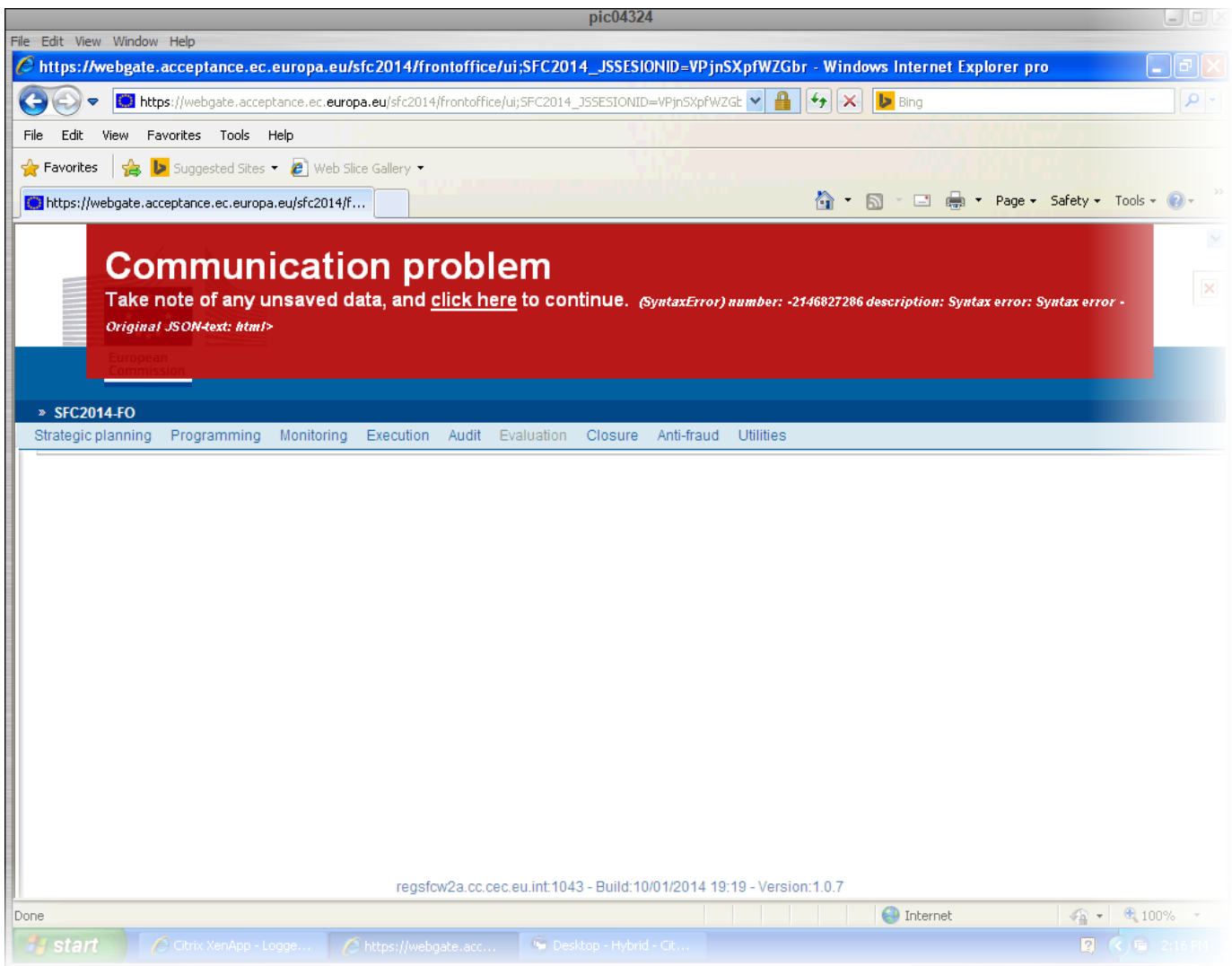


Issue - I always get a Communication problem error and cannot access SFC2014. What should I do?

A **communication problem error** (like the one below) is most likely because you're not using the correct URL to access the application.



Please make sure you're logging in to <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/sfc2014/frontoffice/ui> .

If SFC2014 is saved in your favourites, make sure it is saved correctly like this

<https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/sfc2014/frontoffice/ui> and **not with a string at the end** (eg:
