

Event Registration - Notifications - Why do I receive an email for pending changes in the Event Notification Registration?

SFC2014 is now sending daily automatic email reminders to users with pending changes in their Event Registration. This is a new feature of release **2.15.0**, implemented in production on 20/08/2018.

Unfortunately in the Event Registration module in SFC2014 the pending changes are not highlighted. This means that you cannot see the changes that are still pending. As long as the registration is under revision and changes have not been applied, the email address in the table of contents (on the left side of the screen) will be displayed in red.

In order for the changes to be effective, you need to activate them by clicking on the icon in the last column of the table *Activate changes* :
