

Access - I have an SFC2014 account, does this mean I automatically have access to SFC2021?

No. Existing users of SFC2014 must explicitly request access to SFC2021 by providing their Unique identifier at the Commission (**uid**)? to their MS Liaison.

This Unique identifier at the Commission (**uid**)? is the same one that is used for the SFC2014 account and can be found accessing <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/cas> and logging into EU Login and clicking on the gear at the top right corner to display the menu and select 'My Account' -> 'My EU Login Account Details' -> 'Unique identifier at the Commission (uid)'

Alternatively if a user already has an SFC2014 account they can login to SFC2014 and find their Unique identifier at the Commission (**uid**)? on the top-left of the screen:
