It is with great pleasure that we can announce the release on 8/05/2009 of the updated version of the SFC2007 application which contains:

- All the functionalities of previous versions;
- Certain minor corrections and change requests;
- Features to include the **New Challenges for EAFRD** according to Commission regulation 363/2009 and Council regulation 74/2009.
- Additionally, please be informed that from today (14/05/2009) onwards, the Management and Control Systems dossier can be sent to the Commission by either the Managing Authority (MSMA) the Member State Authority (MSA) and the Audit Authority (MSAA). The creation and validation of the Dossier remains the task of the Member State Compliance Officer (MSCO). End user documentation (quick guide, manuals and e-learning courses) will be adapted accordingly in the next days.
- Web-services for this version remain unchanged.
