**Subject: Follow-up to the webinar on the key elements of the ex-post evaluation of the AMIF-ISF 2014-2020 National programmes: Consolidated background note and supporting material**

Dear Members of the AMIF-ISF Committee,

Further to the Webinar of 20 July 2023 on the key-elements of the *ex post* evaluation, the comments and questions received, and the Commission's work on collecting relevant data stored by third-party organisations, please find attached:

- the consolidated background note on the ex-post evaluation of the AMIF-ISF 2014-2020 national programmes (in clean and “*track changes*” version);
- the consolidated Power Point presentation of the background note;
- the May 2017 Guidance on the Common Monitoring and Evaluation Framework; and
- templates to be filled in with national level data by the respective Responsible Authorities and uploaded in SFC2014 if possible by the end of September 2024.<sup>1</sup>

Similar to its draft version presented at the Webinar, the consolidated background note presents methodological advice and procedural information for the 2014-2020 ex post evaluation of the national programmes, building upon the May 2017 Guidance on the Common Monitoring and Evaluation Framework.

The consolidated version incorporates:

- information on how to exchange data between the Responsible Authorities and the Commission, and some advice on how to handle data that is not for public dissemination (section 3.2);
- updated information on the next steps (section 4);

- a clarification of the possible reasons for returning an evaluation report (section 5); and
- updated meta-data for the indicators of the Common Monitoring and Evaluation framework (Annex II).

As described in the note, the Responsible Authorities can find available in SFC2014, under the heading “Evaluation/Evaluation documents”, the data collected and processed by the Commission services.
