Technical changes to the report

Table 11: Common and programme-specific indicators and quantified target indicators:

1. Table D:

- I. The achievement of target indicators T6 and T14 partially relies on measures for which the reporting is annual. In line with the approach to report the “highest annual value achieved so far”, the calculation formula for T6 and T14 has been corrected.

2. Table F:

- I. The column for 2018 milestones has been removed; not relevant after completion of the performance review.
- II. Columns to report on expenditure “paid in year n+1 related to year n operations” removed. This reporting was only relevant for the performance review.

3. Table B4

- I. New line “Total public expenditure” referring to the whole RDP. The figure represents cumulative expenditure reported including the three components “EAFRD + national co-funding + national top-ups”
